1st Trimester Report Card



Report cards will go home week of Nov. 13. Grades are given in rubric format in relation to the 5th grade standards. Here is the percentage range for each of the rubric score:

- 4 = Exceed Standard (98-100%)
- **3** = At Standard (70% 97%)
- 2 = Near Standard (40% 69%)
- **1** = Below Standard (1% 39%)

The goal is for all students to reach the score of 3 or "At Standard". Please encourage your child to continue to do well or give more effort in the 2nd Trimester. As always, please let me know if you have questions or concerns. Thank you! Accelerated Reader
