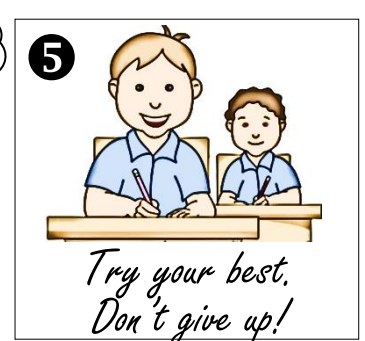
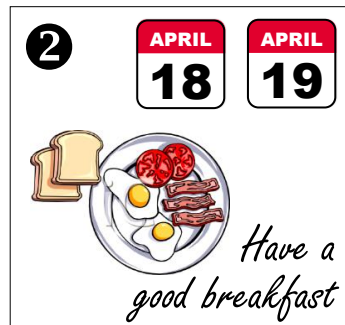
Once testing has started (9:30am), our classroom **WILL NOT** be interrupted for any reason. Late students will be in the office for the duration and will have to retest on another day.
