We are doing this because we know the importance of reading in education, and we want to develop a lifelong love for reading.

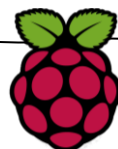
Please support our class in this very difficult challenge by making sure that your child has a time and place to **read at home everyday for 20-30 minutes.**

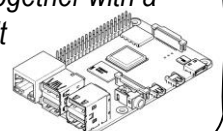
## Website Project

**1** = Below Standard (1% - 39%)

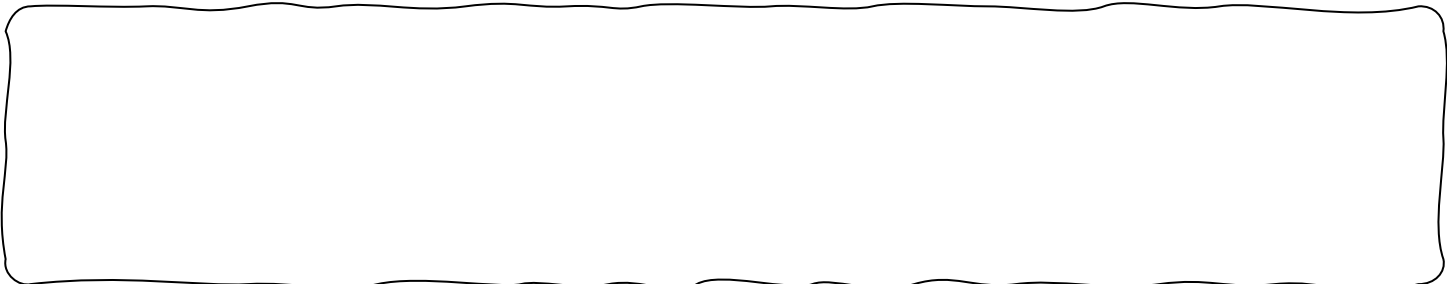
