Your Team is assigned to research the lives of the earliest settlers of the United States, better known as Native Americans. You will work together and divide topics to research your region. You will display your information on a Google Slide Presentation (10 slides maximum).

Your presentation needs to include the following sections:

- **1. Geography** Include a map of where your Native American region was. List any landforms, mountains, bodies of water... that are important to your region's tribes.
- 2. Natural Resources What useful materials, such as soil, plants, animals, food sources... that your region's tribes used for food, clothing, shelter.
- **3. Culture** Identify what made your group of people unique. Share what the lifestyle of your group was like (role of adults, children, family life, clothing, spiritual beliefs, etc.).
- **4. Shelter** Include pictures of your region's tribal homes. What was used to build them? How were they heated? How many people lived in a home? What were the homes called?
- **5. Technology** Identify inventions (tools, weapons, etc.) that made life easier for the tribes in your region.
- **6.** Local Tribe Choose a tribe in your region and add a section with information about the tribe on your presentation.
- **7. Bonus Project: Create, build, construct, draw, or paint** (arts, crafts, dwellings, artifacts, video, etc.) that demonstrate the culture and uniqueness of the tribes in your region.
 - Diorama of shelter and/or tribal life
 - A video talking/acting/showing your region
 - Dream catchers, totem poles...
 - Technology (tools, pottery, utensils...)
 - Clothing, headdress, jewelry, masks
